

The Breaking of Bread in EmmausMay 1Luke 24:28-35

Object Lessons and Storytelling Ideas

- Act out somebody learning about something really amazing that they feel compelled to share with everybody they talk to. That's how these men felt this was an amazing thing that they just had to share, and it's amazing for us too!
- Act out the story and the men sharing with everybody after, or have a 'reporter' interviewing them about what they saw. (This could be a theme for the next few weeks interviewing eyewitnesses to Jesus.)
- The Bible Project has a <u>Luke 24 overview video</u> that could be useful for your own preparation or to show older kids.

Discussion Ideas and Questions

- How do you think the disciples felt when they recognized Jesus? How did their lives change now that they had seen Jesus?
- This is a good example of repentance the men believed something that was wrong, and when they realized what was true they turned around and went the opposite direction.
- It was when Jesus broke the bread that they recognized him. When was the last time Jesus had broken bread (eaten) with his disciples? When we have communion, how are we recognizing Jesus?

At Home Connections

- How can you as a family share the good news that Jesus is alive? Are you living in such a way that your neighbours and friends know that you follow Christ?
- Bake bread together as a family. While you bake (and eat!), talk about the things that you know are true about Jesus.
