Jesus is No Ghost May 8 Luke 24:36-42

Object Lessons and Storytelling Ideas

- Imagine if Jesus was like a ghost in stories popping up everywhere saying "boo!" Is that what Jesus is like? You could also act this out with puppets.
- Skit idea: call in ghostbusters to save the disciples! But wait... Jesus isn't a ghost we called the wrong people! But you sure are glad to hear the good news that Jesus is alive!
- Who is hungry this morning? Who has a scar or something that hurts? All these things are part of your body; did you know that after Jesus was resurrected he still had all these things too? He had a realy body with scars and still ate food. His body was also different he could appear and disappear, and even though he had scars he didn't have any pain. He still had a body, but it was different now too!
- The Bible Project has a <u>Luke 24 overview video</u> that could be useful for your own preparation or to show older kids.

Discussion Ideas and Questions

- Jesus was still Jesus after his resurrection, and he's still the same Jesus today! Do you know what Jesus is doing now?
- What do you think Jesus' friends were thinking when he asked for food? They gave him some fish what would you have given Jesus to eat?
- Why did it matter for Jesus' disciples to know he had a real body after his resurrection?

- What scars do you have? What stories do they tell?
- Make whatever you think you'd like to give Jesus in celebration of his resurrection and have a celebration supper!
